## **CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020**

# Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class (es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

### **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier, and ICS will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

### Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Below is a list of Best Practices for the GFDTC Agility Trial to comply with AKC Guidelines. We are committed to providing a safe environment for our exhibitors, workers, and judges!

<u>Crating:</u> Crating space indoors is limited. We encourage exhibitors to be prepared to crate out of their car. No ex-pens allowed indoors. Crates may be left overnight; however FM Kennel Club or the GFDTC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

<u>Building Access:</u> The Main Entrance of the building (North side) will have one door dedicated entrance and exit. Please follow the signs when you arrive.

Check-In: Agility Gate will be used.

Posting Results: Results will be posted on site.

Course Maps: Maps will be posted on site and emailed to exhibitors once available from the Judge.

<u>Walk-Throughs:</u> Decisions for walk-through splits will be made upon closing of the trial; limited to a maximum of 25 exhibitors/walk-through.

**Leashes:** There are two options:

Option 1: Leash runner may use a "grabber" if they want to move your leash to the ground by the exit gate.

Option 2: Exhibitor can place the leash in your pocket, around your neck, or around your waist.

NOTE: if the dog grabs the leash while running this will be scored as an "E".

Briefing: General briefing will provided each day. Delivery will be determined by the judge.

Ribbons/Awards: Ribbons are self-service. Ribbons and labels will be provided for exhibitors.

<u>Communication:</u> During the trial, we understand that people will be spread out an not know what is happening by the ring. After the trial closes, confirmed exhibitors will receive information on how updates will be communicated.

<u>DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER</u>: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

REFUNDS: Entry Fees for females that come into season will be refunded (minus a \$12.00 administrative fee per day) prior to the start of judging. Refunds for dogs injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$12.00 administrative fee per day) with a valid veterinary note and written notification received within 24 hours prior to the start of judging. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge, or banned from competition by action of the trial committee.
